Costs

You will be responsible for your own flight but we can help arrange that as you like. A check in May for prices showed them at less than \$600.00. Team costs include housing, transportation, the day off at the beach, administration, insurance, and money towards the cost of the buildings. Additional money for the construction part of the trip will be raised separately. Trip cost is \$995. There is an additional application fee of \$49.

Project Description

To construct a ministry training, camping, and retreat center for King's Castle Ministries with the Assemblies of God National Church. King's Castle Ministries is committed to "forming disciples with a missionary vision to win children and youth to the Lord." Buildings to be constructed include dorms, kitchen, dining hall, sanctuary and prayer rooms, gym, and amphitheatre. It will be called the Caribbean Institute for Missions Advancement (CIMA).

This will include but not be limited to cement block walls, concrete floors, plumbing, electrical, poured roofs, installation of windows and doors, painting, and sewing.
